Friday 9th Midnight Dynamos

The Midnight Dynamos, originally started out as a duo in 1993, created by the brothers Colin Temple on Guitar and lead Vocals, Steve Temple on Drums and Vocals. They decided to call themselves The Midnight Dynamos, a hit record for a band called Matchbox in the Eighties and the brothers loved the name and the song and thought it would be perfect for the name of the Duo. Permission was granted for use of the name by Mr Graham Fenton the lead singer with Matchbox and the song writer, Steve Bloomfield who wrote the song and also the lead guitarist with Matchbox was overjoyed that they wanted to use this name, so Midnight Dynamos began. In 1994/1995 the duo was joined on Bass by their friend Brett Harrison. also helped out on Vocals which brought a bigger sound. Brett stayed with the trio for approximately 1 year and then decided he wanted to do different things so the boys where then joined by a good friend Ricky Sherwood on bass and vocals
